PDG Rtn. Abhinandan A. Shetty

PDG Rtn. Abhinandan A. Shetty, lovingly called "Abhi," was born on 12th December 1972. He had his early education in Kundapura and completed his Bachelor of Business Management (B.B.M.) degree from St. Aloysius College, Mangalore. Mr. Shetty acquired the degree of B.A. (Interdepartmental Studies) from Schiller International University, Strasbourg, France, and his M.B.A.

(International Business) from Schiller International University, London, U.K. During his student days, he extensively travelled throughout Europe and the United States. He is currently managing the family's diverse business interests, including hotels, resorts, plantations, floriculture, and educational institutions.

A third-generation Rotarian, Abhinandan is a proud member of the Rotary Club of Kundapura South. He began his Rotary journey as a Rotaractor in 1998, became president of the Rotaract Club of Kundapura South (1999-2000). He served as District Community Service Director, earning the Best District Director Award, and was the team leader of the inter-district youth exchange program to Nepal and RI District 3290 (West Bengal) in 1998.

He was the District Rotaract Representative (DRR) of RI District 3180 (2002-03) and is regarded as one of the district's most successful DRRs. In 2006-07, as District Rotaract chairman, he was instrumental in chartering 40 new Rotaract clubs, the highest ever in the district. He has since been a regular trainer, counselor, and resource person at numerous Rotary, Rotaract, District Assembly, and RYLA programs.

Mr.Shetty has attended Rotary International Conventions in Los Angeles (2008), Lisbon (2013), Atlanta (2017), and Hamburg (2019). He has participated in numerous RYLA programs since 1999 at both district and national levels and served as a counsellor at the International RYLA during the 2008 Rotary International Convention in Los Angeles. He was District RYLA Chairman (2010-11); Chairman of Akshata 2010, the District Interact Conference; President of Rotary Club of Kundapura South (2011-12); Assistant Governor, Zone 1, RI District 3180 (2012-13); Chairman of ROTASIA 2014, the Rotaract South Asia Conference held in Mysore; and Chairman of Unnathi 2014, the District Membership and Polio Plus Orientation Seminar.

In recognition of his exceptional leadership, Rtn. Abhinandan Shetty was elected unopposed as the District Governor of RI Dist. 3182 for 2018-19, becoming the youngest District Governor in the history of the dist. During his governorship, he received the distinction of Star Performer for Public Image and achieved 100% contribution to the Rotary Foundation.

His leadership has extended far beyond the district. He served as Joint Secretary of the Rotary Zone Institute 2019 held at Indore; Asst. Rotary Public Image Coordinator (ARPIC), Zone 7 (2020-21 and 2023-24); Assistant Rotary Coordinator (ARC), Zone 7 (2024-25); and is presently serving as Rotary Public Image Coordinator (RPIC), Zone 7 (2025-28).

He has also represented the Rotary International president as the president's special representative at the district conferences of RI Dist. 3020 (2020-21) and RI Dist. 3261 (2022-23). He served as Dist. Trainer of RI Dist. 3182 (2022-23 and 2023-24), chaired the Rotaract Seminar at the Rotary Zone Institute, Bengaluru (2023), and was the vice chair of TEJAS Rotary Zone Institute, New Delhi (2025).

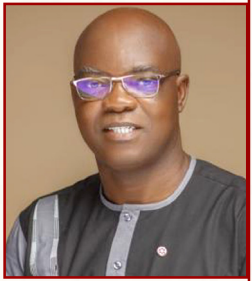

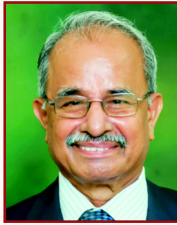

Topic: Thanks giving

WELCOME ADDRESS : The President, Rtn. Dr. M. S. Arun Kumar Shetty, warmly welcomed the invited guests, Rotarians, Anns, and Annettes.

THANKS GIVING ADDRESS : The President expressed his sincere gratitude to all members and office bearers who contributed to making the Rotary year 2025-26 a memorable and successful journey. He thanked the Secretary, Rtn. Shambavi Prabhu; IPP, Rtn. Mohan C. Nair; PDG K. Krishna Shetty; President-elect Rtn. Sudharshan Nayak; and all committee members for their dedicated service in line with the motto "Service Above Self."

He acknowledged the successful execution of various initiatives, including global and district grants, Pulse Polio activities, medical camps, Alzheimer's awareness programmes, yoga initiatives, and significant contributions to the Rotary Foundation. These efforts were recognised through multiple Excellence Awards received during the year.

YEARLY HIGHLIGHTS (2025-26) : The club successfully achieved all 26 goals set for the year and received the Club Excellence Award. A total of 131 projects were completed, benefiting around 8,600 people across community service, youth development, vocational service, public image, and club service initiatives.

The club recorded an all-time high contribution of \$14,517.30 to the Rotary Foundation, including both Annual Fund and Polio Fund contributions. It secured top rankings at the district level and achieved several recognitions, including the Early Achiever Award and 100% Polio Plus Contribution status.

Administrative improvements included better record maintenance systems, clearing property tax dues, registering a new charitable trust deed, and electing new trustees. The club also launched its official website and achieved 100% registration on My Rotary.

The club actively participated in district events and won several awards, including Global Excellence Award, Adoptability Excellence Award, Impact Excellence Award, and Bulletin Excellence Award.

RESPONSE TO THANKS GIVING : Members appreciated the achievements of the club and credited the President's leadership for the remarkable progress. Several members described the year as impactful, progressive, and enhancing the club's image, while expressing continued support for future initiatives.

ANNOUNCEMENTS : Groceries worth Rs. 23,677 were donated to Snehadeepa Aid Rehabilitation Center, with Rtn. Dr. Shivaprasad contributing 50% of the cost. On the occasion of Polio Day, breakfast was distributed at PHC centres in Mannaguda, Lady Hill, and Bokkapatna. The registration of the club bylaws was also announced.

The club conveyed warm wishes to all Rotarians, Anns, Annettes, and their family members celebrating birthdays and anniversaries during the week.

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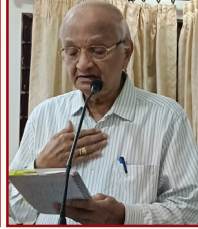
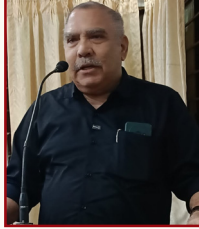
