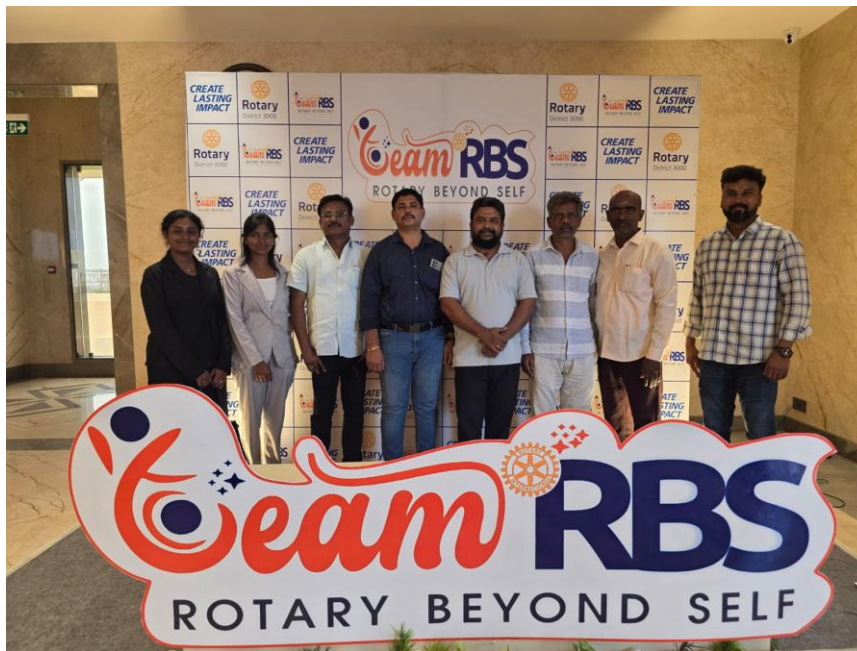

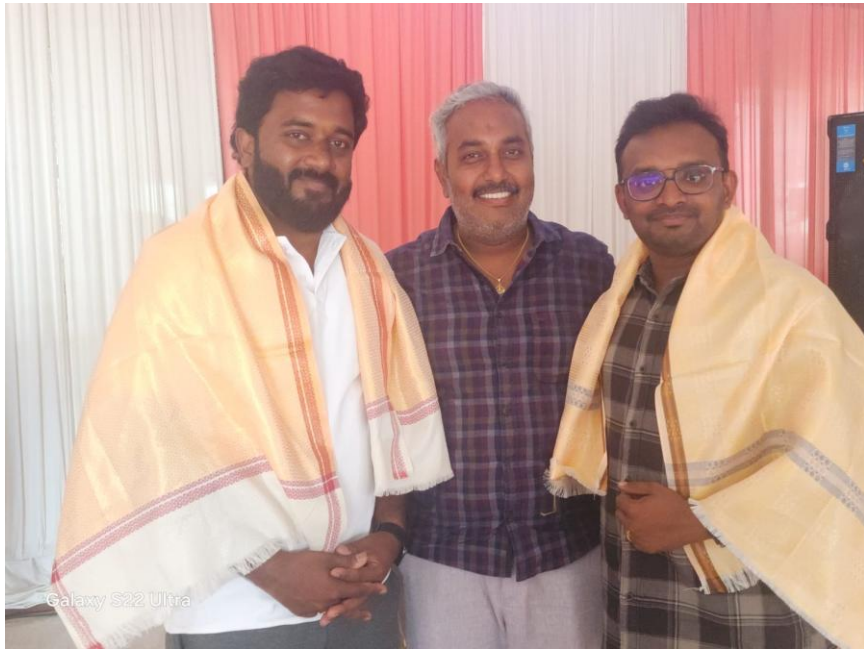


7. Rotary Club of Palani - Installation

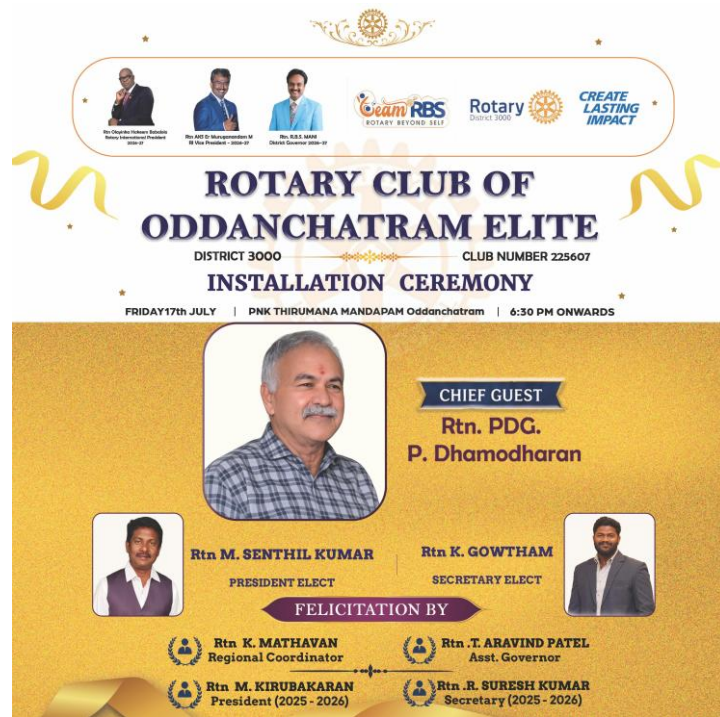

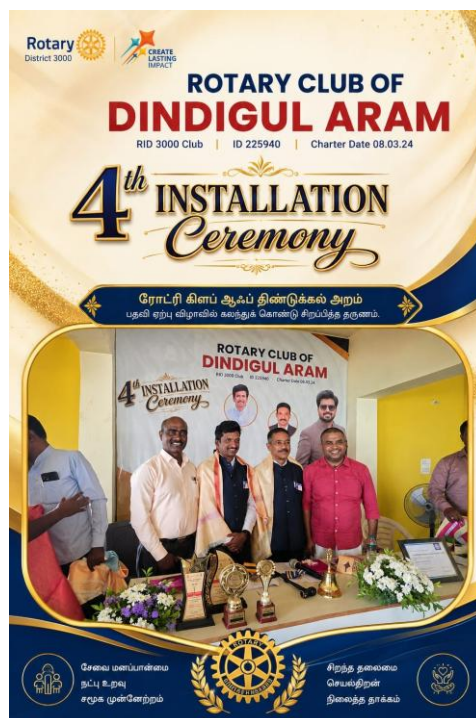

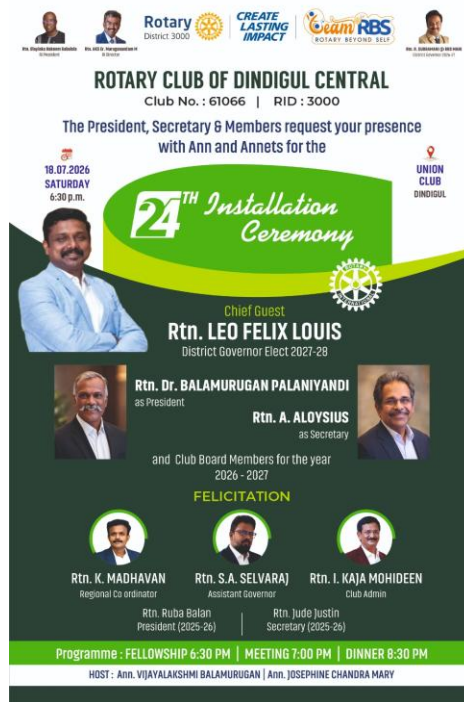
