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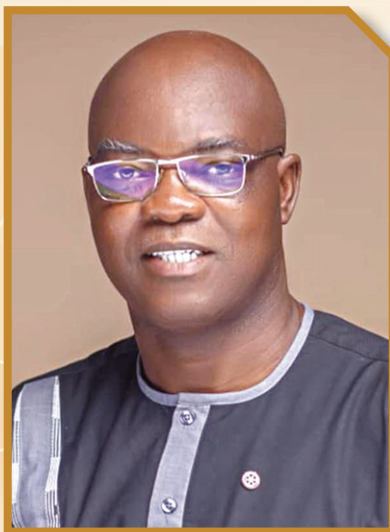

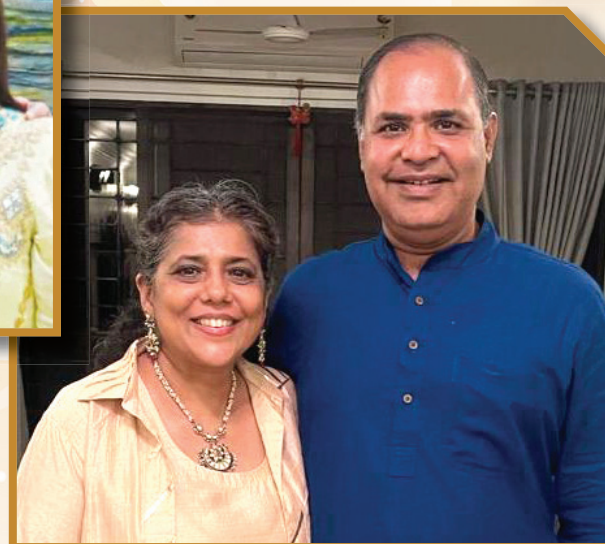

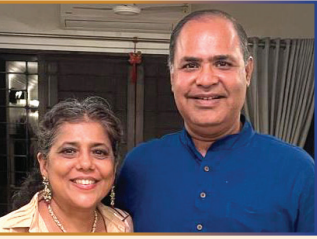

Rtn. Dr. Kamal D'Mello, Secretary

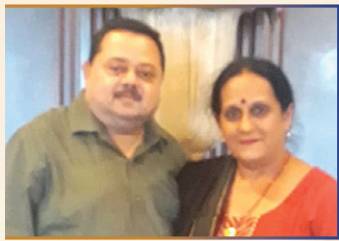

Rtn. Shefaali Shah, Director Community Service – I

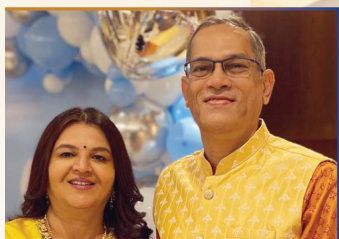

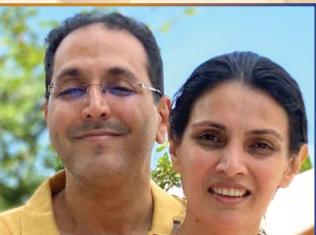

PP Rtn. Aslam Merchant, *Club Learning Facilitator*

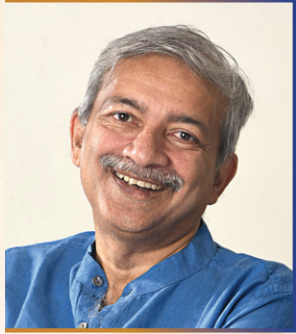
