FROM PRESIDENT'S DESK

In keeping with our commitment to caring for the elderly and the underprivileged, support was extended to Sai Ashraya Old Age Home at Nere, Panvel, which houses 36 elderly residents, including several terminally ill patients. Essential items such as bedsheets, diapers, and hand gloves were donated. This will help improve hygiene, comfort, and dignity for the residents.

The fellowship meeting held on 9th May 2026 was both engaging and intellectually stimulating. A lively debate was organized based on the Four-Way Test and the principles of Rotary. Participants expressed their views, leading to meaningful discussions and a deeper understanding of Rotary values. Thus it strengthened the bond between Rotary and Rotaract members.

Another memorable fellowship was organized on 23rd May 2026 on the rooftop of the 42nd floor of Kalpataru Avana. Against the backdrop of a spectacular city skyline, members spent a delightful evening filled with camaraderie, conversations, and laughter. The gathering provided an excellent opportunity for members and their families to connect and further strengthen the spirit of friendship that forms the foundation of Rotary.

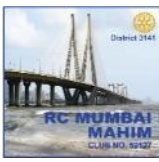

PR Shaila, along with Rtn. Lalit, attended the camp.

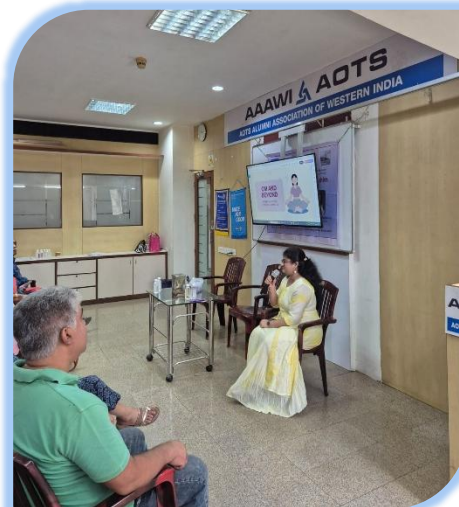


OM CHANTING SESSION BY AYUSHI DOLE

LIGHTING THE PATH TO A SAFER TOMORROW – DONATION OF SOLAR LIGHTS

Access to proper street lighting is essential for the safety, security and well-being of rural communities. In many villages, the absence of street lights restricts movement after sunset, affects daily activities, and poses challenges for the elderly, women and children. Solar street lights provide an environmentally friendly and sustainable solution by harnessing renewable energy, reducing dependence on conventional power sources, and ensuring reliable illumination even in remote areas.

Recognizing this need, RCMM undertook a community service project at Zimanwadi village, Dapoli, where the village streets had no lighting facilities. To improve safety and ease of movement during the night, RCMM donated six Solar Street Lights for the benefit of the villagers.

The project was inaugurated by Rtn. Dr. Ajay Darekar, who appreciated the initiative and its positive impact on the community. With the installation of these solar lights, villagers can now move about safely after dark without having to depend on lanterns or other temporary lighting arrangements.

This project is expected to benefit approximately 250 villagers, enhancing their quality of life while promoting the use of clean and sustainable energy.



SUPPORT TO SAI ASHRAYA OLD AGE HOME AT NEREPADA PANVEL

Sai Ashraya Old Age Home, located at Nerepada near Panvel, is a caring residential facility dedicated to providing shelter, comfort, and dignity to senior citizens who require support and assistance in their later years. The home accommodates elderly residents from diverse backgrounds, including some who are suffering from age-related ailments and terminal illnesses. Managed with compassion and commitment, the institution ensures a clean, safe, and nurturing environment where residents receive proper care, nutritious freshly prepared meals, medical attention, and emotional support.

On 26th May 2026, PR Shaila along with Rtn. Lalit visited the old age home and RCMM donated 36 bedsheets 4 diaper packs of 30 each and 4 packets of hand gloves as requested by them.

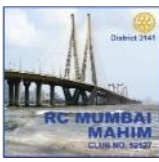

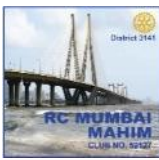

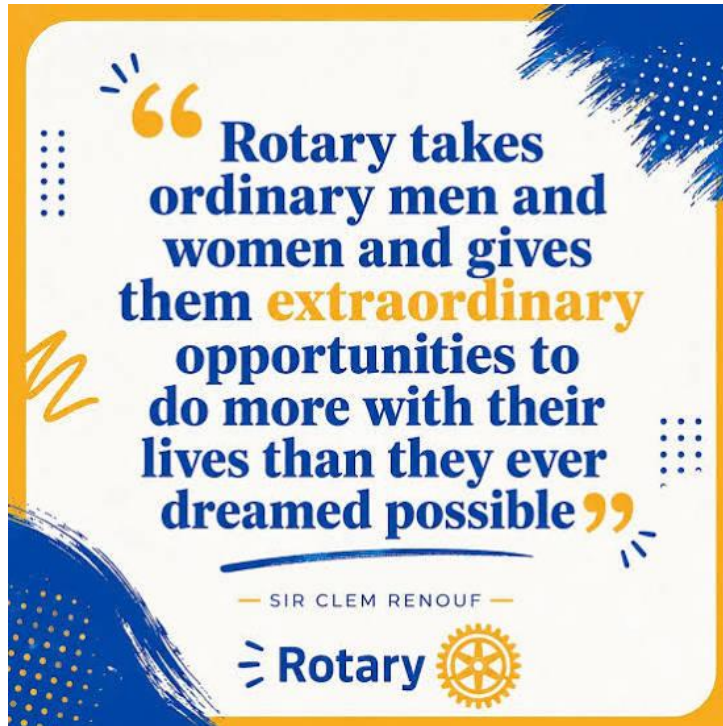

Thyroid health: Warning signs you need to watch out for

I am a 35-year-old man and have noticed a swelling at the front of my neck. It is painless, but gradually increasing in size. Should I be worried?

— **Kunal Mehta**

A swelling at the front of the neck may arise from the thyroid and should not be ignored. While many thyroid nodules are non-cancerous, some may require further evaluation to rule out cancer. Clinical examination, thyroid function tests and ultrasound of the neck are the first steps in assessment. If required, a fine needle aspiration biopsy may be advised. Most tumours are treatable when detected early, hence timely consultation with a specialist is recommended.

Thyroid cancer runs in my family. My mother and uncle

were both diagnosed with it. Am I at a higher risk of getting cancer?

— **Rohan Iyer**

Certain thyroid cancers, especially medullary thyroid cancer, can have a familial association. A family history of thyroid cancer may increase your risk and should not be ignored. However, it does not necessarily mean you will develop thyroid cancer. Clinical examinations, thyroid ultrasound and genetic testing can help identify problems early. Screening is im-

portant if multiple family members are affected or if thyroid cancer occurred at a younger age. Early detection allows excellent long-term outcomes in most patients.
I am a 42-year-old woman and have been advised thyroid

surgery. I am worried about the risks, especially loss of voice. Is thyroid surgery safe?

— **Neha Kapoor**

Thyroid surgery is generally very safe when performed by an experienced head-neck surgeon. However, like any surgery, it carries certain risks that patients should be aware of. Common concerns include temporary voice change due to irritation near the vocal cord nerve, low calcium caused by temporary disturbance of the parathyroid glands, bleeding and infection. Permanent complications are rare in expert hands. Modern surgical techniques and careful nerve identification have significantly improved outcomes. Before surgery, your surgeon will advise blood tests, ultrasound and vocal cord assessment to plan treatment. Most patients recover well and return to normal activities within a short period.
