Outgoing Immediate Past President (IPP) Rtn. Mitesh Vadhia presented a comprehensive yearly report, highlighting the club's exceptional achievements over the past year. Adding to the nostalgic pride of the milestone, PP Rtn. Bhupender Juneja delivered an enlightening presentation that beautifully scanned the 60 glorious years of RCBJ's history.

International Presence & New Inductions

Reflecting Rotary's global spirit, the event was also attended by International Youth Exchange (IYE) student Davin Böckel from Germany, who was warmly welcomed alongside his parents, Carmen Böckel and Thorsten Böckel.

In another proud moment for the club's growing family, Mr. Yogesh Patel and Mrs. Heena Patel were formally inducted as new members by the District Governor.

The Installation and Oath-Taking

PP Rtn. Dilip Shah formally introduced District Governor Rtn. Nilesh Shah to the assembly. Following this, PP Rtn. Hemang Vahia introduced the incoming visionary leader, Rtn. Girish Dhar.



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DG Rtn. Nilesh Shah officially installed Rtn. Girish Dhar as the 60th President of the club, alongside the Board of Directors (BOD) for RY 2026-27. The DG administered a solemn oath in Hindi and pinned the incoming team, empowering them for the year ahead.

Vision for RY 2026-27 & Flagship Projects

In his inaugural address, President Rtn. Girish Dhar congratulated the members on reaching the Diamond Jubilee milestone and laid out an ambitious roadmap for the year. Key flagship initiatives announced include:

- **Rotary Skill Centre at Kawant:** To be established in association with the Don Bosco School to empower local youth. This will be one of a kind direct RCBJ project.
- **Project Poshan:** Launched at UHC Channi and UHC Atladra to tackle malnutrition.

Demonstrating immediate action, the DG and First Lady actively participated in Project Poshan during the event, distributing nutritious protein kits to underprivileged pregnant ladies.

Past District Governor (PDG) Rtn. Pinky Patel addressed the gathering, sharing words of wisdom and motivating the club to scale new heights.

In his keynote address, DG Rtn. Nilesh Shah challenged the club to focus on growing effective membership and urged every member to contribute generously to The Rotary Foundation. He also passionately shared his grand district vision for project "Jeevan Setu - Blood Stem Cell Registry", emphasizing its life-saving potential.

Following his enlightening address, a special felicitation took place where President Rtn. Girish Dhar felicitated DG Rtn. Nilesh Shah by presenting him with a beautiful hand-woven shawl, and First Lady Ann Shruti Shah was presented with a shawl by club First Lady Ann Neeta Dhar.

The Rotary Skill Centre @ Kawant in collaboration with Disha Don Bosco is being created to establish a long-term training hub which facilitates to impart vocational skills - to our rural youth - at their doorstep and to provide sustainable livelihoods within the rural areas. This will be a permanent sanctuary of empowerment where underprivileged youth and women can learn

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livelihood skills, breaking the cycle of poverty forever.

We will continue honouring excellence in our community - through our signature - Vocational Awards, celebrating local unsung heroes - who practice their trade with absolute integrity - and exemplify the 4-Way Test in their professions.

We shall expand the ambit of Project Poshan. Here we are partnering with local government clinics for monthly distribution of Nutrition kits to about 100 underprivileged pregnant ladies to combat neonatal malnutrition. We are happy that our DG and FL participated in the drive today at UHC Atladra, ensuring healthy mothers and healthy babies.

It is our desire to partner with local hospitals to conduct regular vision, dental, and general health checkups in rural schools, providing free follow-up medicines or spectacles. We will celebrate our Diamond Jubilee by conducting Mega Blood donation drives organized in association with leading blood banks to support regional emergency supplies.

Our target is to promote high-survival tree sapling plantation in urban blocks and school grounds to mark our 60-year milestone sustainably. We have scheduled one such drive at the Rotary Skill Centre on the 11th of this month.

Rotary thrives on fresh energy and diverse perspectives. Increasing our membership isn't just about growing our roster—it is about expanding our capacity to serve. Every new member brings a new passion, a new network, and a new opportunity to change lives in our community. Let us make it our collective mission this year to invite changemakers into our fold, showing them that Rotary is where their desire to do good becomes reality. We must ensure retention of our existing members.

Rotary Fellowship is the foundational bond of mutual respect, friendship, and shared values that unites members before, during, and after service projects. We have planned an exciting year ahead.

We are committed to aligning closely with DG Nilesh Shah's district focus areas and maintain 100% participation in District 3060 conclaves. We are happy to share that already 5 couple registrations are done for the District Conference in Silvassa.

RCBJ has done well in channelizing funds to The Rotary Foundation (TRF) to support global grants. Last year we have crossed the US\$ 75 K mark with contributions from esteemed members towards TRF, Directed grant and CSR funding via Rotary. We plan to continue the efforts towards this goal.

Babalola has played a significant role in Rotary's fight against polio, serving on the End Polio Now Countdown to History Campaign Committee (2017–23) and the Nigeria National PolioPlus Committee, where he continues to serve as an adviser.

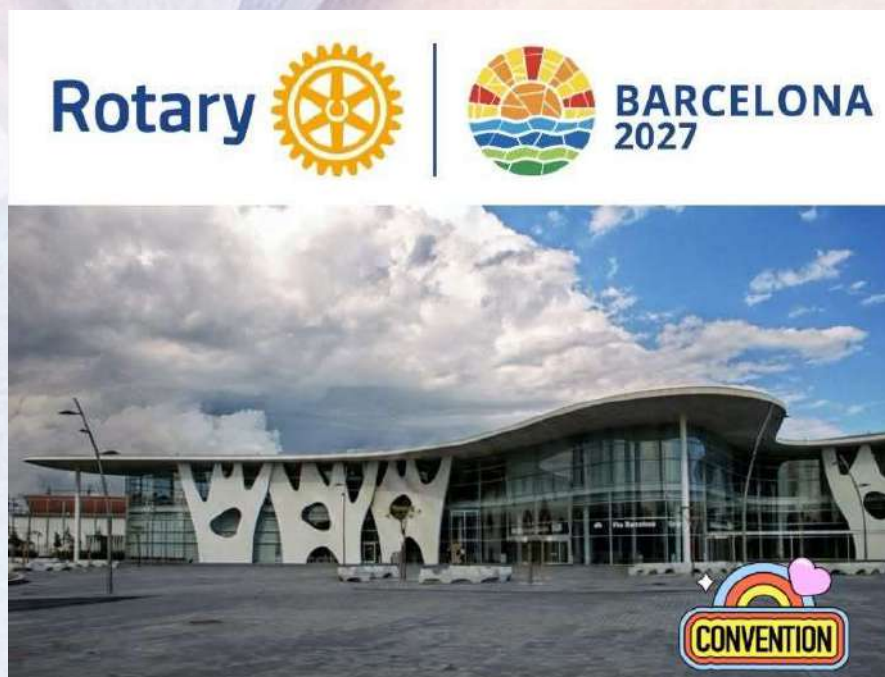
A graduate engineer, he completed his university degree in 1988 and spent over twenty-five years in the oil and gas industry, holding senior leadership positions with Shell PLC. He is the founder of Riviera Technical Services Ltd., an oil and gas infrastructure delivery company, and Lead and Change Consulting, an executive coaching and organizational performance advisory group.

His professional affiliations include the Nigerian Society of Engineers, the Institute of Safety Professionals of Nigeria, and the Association of Change Management Professionals. He is also a member of the Jericho Businessmen Club of Ibadan.

His Rotary journey began through the Rotaract Club of Vapi in 1993, where he immediately earned recognition as Best Rotaract of the Year. During his tenure as Rotaract Club President (2000–01), the club received Best Club and Best President Awards at the district level.

His visionary Rotaract Garden Project at Gunjan, Vapi became a landmark initiative and earned him the prestigious Outstanding Young Indian Award from JCI India in 2002.

As Charter Member and Charter Secretary of **Rotary Club of Vapi Riverside**, he played a pivotal role in establishing a culture of impactful service. His contributions earned him several recognitions including Four Avenues of Service Award, Club Builder Award, and Rotarian of the Year Award.

As Club President in 2010–11, he led landmark projects including collection of 917 units of blood, support for over 75 cleft palate surgeries, and laying the foundation of Rotary Vanchetna Kanya Chhatralay. Under his leadership the club received Best Club, Best President, RI President Citation with Distinction, and Platinum Club Recognition.

At the district level, he served in several important leadership positions including Assistant Governor, District Secretary, Literacy Chair, and PHS Promotion Chair. His leadership at the renowned Sneh–Sindhu Conference demonstrated his exceptional ability to unite people and transform ideas into action.

He is married to Shruti Shah and together they are Major Donors Level 1. Their daughters Vrushti and Yuti carried the Rotary legacy forward through Rotaract, Interact, and the International Youth Exchange Program. Both are Paul Harris Fellows and are now settled in Canada.

Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar Marks Diamond Jubilee with Launch of "Project Poshan" for Maternal Health

The Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar (RCBJ) officially commenced its landmark Diamond Jubilee year (2026-27) under the leadership of incoming President Rtn. Girish Dhar by launching "Project Poshan," a monthly nutritional support initiative for underprivileged pregnant women.

Marking 60 years of community service, RCBJ has planned an array of impactful service projects for this milestone year under the direction of Club Service Chair PP Rtn. Hemang Vahia. The flagship "Project Poshan" is led by Project Chair PP Rtn. Dr. Jayant Sastry, with seamless coordination executed by Hon. Secretary Vivek Duggal. The list of recipients within the corporation limits of Vadodara is prepared by Dr. Nitin Parmar - the RCH Officer, VMSS.

The launch events took place on 7th July across two locations: the Urban Health Centre (UHC) in Channi at 12:30 PM, and the UHC in Atladra at 4:00 PM. The event saw strong, hands-on community participation as Rotarians and Anns from RCBJ were seen in full action, managing the logistics and engaging with the community throughout the distribution drive.

The program was graced by District Governor Rtn. Nilesh Shah and First Lady Shruti Shah, who actively participated in the distributions and directly addressed the gathering to emphasize maternal wellness and community-led healthcare. IPP Rtn. Mitesh Vadhia, PP Rtn. Hemang Vahia, PP Rtn. Dr. Jayant Sastry, Hon. Secretary Vivek Duggal, PP Chandresh Makhija, PE Rtn. Manish Shah & Ann Falguni Shah

Key Highlights of the Initiative:

- **Target Beneficiaries:** 100 underprivileged pregnant ladies received crucial health and dietary intervention.
- **High-Protein Nutrition Kits:** To combat maternal malnutrition, each beneficiary received a comprehensive food kit containing:
 - Wheat: 3 kg
 - Moong Dal: 1 kg
 - Roasted Channa: 1 kg
 - Jaggery: 1 kg
 - Groundnut Oil: 1 kg
 - Groundnuts: 1 kg
- **Socio-Economic Empowerment:** Prioritizing sustainable local livelihoods, the nutrition items were packed in durable bags stitched by the women of Mahila Gruh Udyog, providing them with valuable supplemental income.
- **Sustained Care:** Rather than a one-time distribution, RCBJ will continue providing these high-protein kits to the beneficiaries on a strict monthly basis.

Speaking at the launch, President Rtn. Girish Dhar highlighted that initiating their historic Diamond Jubilee year with a project bridging healthcare and women's economic empowerment sets the perfect, service-driven tone for the club's upcoming year-long celebrations.
